

Options for Voter Registration (or Updating Address):

Those who have a valid Michigan Driver's License or State ID, can register at [Mi.gov/Vote](https://mi.gov/vote)

- or -

Register by mail: Applications are available on the City website

- or -

Register in person at the Clerk's office

Voter Registration Deadlines:

- Online or by mail:

Up to 15 days before election

- In person at the Clerk's office: Through election day (proof of residency required during last 14 days before election day)

What's on the ballot?

Beginning a month before election day, voters can preview their ballot at [Mi.gov/Vote](https://mi.gov/vote) or pick up a sample ballot at the Clerk's office.

2024 Elections:

Presidential Primary:

February 27th*

Primary Election:

August 6th

General Election:

November 5th

Early Voting:

Starts 11 days before election day (Saturday) and ends

2 days before election day (Sunday)

Polls open daily 8am—4pm

Absentee Timeline:

Applications available:

75 days before election

Ballots available to be issued:

45 days before election

Applying by mail:

Recommended to submit at least 2 weeks ahead of election

Applying in person:

Ends at 4:00 pm on the day before election

Absentee Ballots Due:

8:00 pm on Election Day

VOTING METHOD #1

ABSENTEE

Any registered voter can vote with an absentee ballot. There is no requirement for an excuse.

There are 2 steps to this process:

1) Submit a ballot application

(unless you have previously submitted a permanent ballot application)

2) Return your voted ballot

by mail or absentee ballot drop box (location listed on front of brochure)

BALLOTS MUST ARRIVE AT CLERK'S OFFICE BEFORE 8:00 PM ON ELECTION DAY

Absentee Application Options:

- Online at [Mi.gov/Vote](https://mi.gov/vote)
- Request from the Clerk's office
- Visit the Clerk's office

Returning your ballot to City Hall or one of the drop boxes is strongly recommended instead of mailing - especially in the last week before the election.

THE OUTSIDE OF THE BALLOT ENVELOPE MUST BE SIGNED BY VOTER!

VOTING METHOD #2

IN PERSON - EARLY ✓

Any voter can vote during the 9 day early voting period for all state and federal elections

VOTING METHOD #3

IN PERSON ON ELECTION DAY ✓

**Polls are open
7 am - 8 pm on election day**

Vote at your assigned precinct as noted on your Voter Information Card or check [Mi.gov/Vote](https://mi.gov/vote) for precinct location.
