Making Progress

It's happening right now! Join us in making it happen.

As part of the EPA's river clean-up, more than 6,900 ft of the Kalamazoo
River bank has been excavated and restored.

- Amount of PCB-laden sediment excavated: 36,000 cu yds in 2007 & 83,000 cu yds projected for 2008
 - Breakdown: About 3,300 cu yds of the excavated material had PCB concentrations in excess of 50 parts per million
 - · Access roads built: 1.5 miles
 - · Cost of clean-up over 2-year work period: \$30 million
 - Number of community input meetings regarding the Plainwell Paper Mill: 3
 - City investment toward acquisition & improvements: \$865,000
 - Successful lobbying effort by the City of Plainwell allows the site to use TIF revenue for demolition, infrastructure, lead or asbestos abatement and site preparation.
